
Sex Reversal

• A process that changes the sexual identity of an individual from one sex to the other.

Sex Reversal

- **Protandrous hermaphrodites-**they start life as males, reach maturity at three or four and, a year or so later, become female. Ex. Seabass, *Lates calcarifer*
- A **protogynous hermaphrodite** is an animal that begins its life cycle as a female. As the animal ages, based on internal or external triggers, it shifts sex to become a male animal. Ex. Grouper, *Epinephelus tauvina*





Sex Reversal

• Gonadotropin-releasing hormone (GnRH), known as **Luteinizing-hormone**releasing hormone (LHRH) and luliberin, is a tropic peptide hormone responsible for the release of FSH and LH from the anterior pituitary. GnRH is synthesized and released from neurons within the hypothalamus. The peptide belongs to gonadotropin-releasing hormone family.
