
Levels of Structural Organization



organs that work together closely

- (2):Cellular level: smallest unit of life, and varies widely in size and shape according to the cell's function
- (3):Tissue level: groups of similar cells having a common function
 - Four basic tissue types: each tissue type has a characteristic role in the body
 - Epithelium: covers the body surface and lines its cavities
 - Muscle: provides movement
 - Connective: supports and protects body organs
 - Nervous: provides a means of rapid internal communication by transmitting electrical impulses

Organ systems consist of different


organs that work together closely

- (4):Organ level: made up of discrete structures that are composed of a least two groups of tissues that work together to perform a specific function in the body
 - Stomach: epithelium lining, muscles, blood vessels, connective tissues, nerve fibers, etc.
- (5):Organ system level: a group of organs that work closely together to accomplish a specific purpose
 - Respiratory and circulatory system, digestive and circulatory systems
- (6):Organismal level: the total of all structures working together to promote life
 - The living human being
