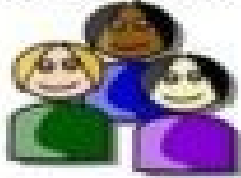

➤ *Person whose goal is to create or capitalize on **new** economic opportunities through innovation*

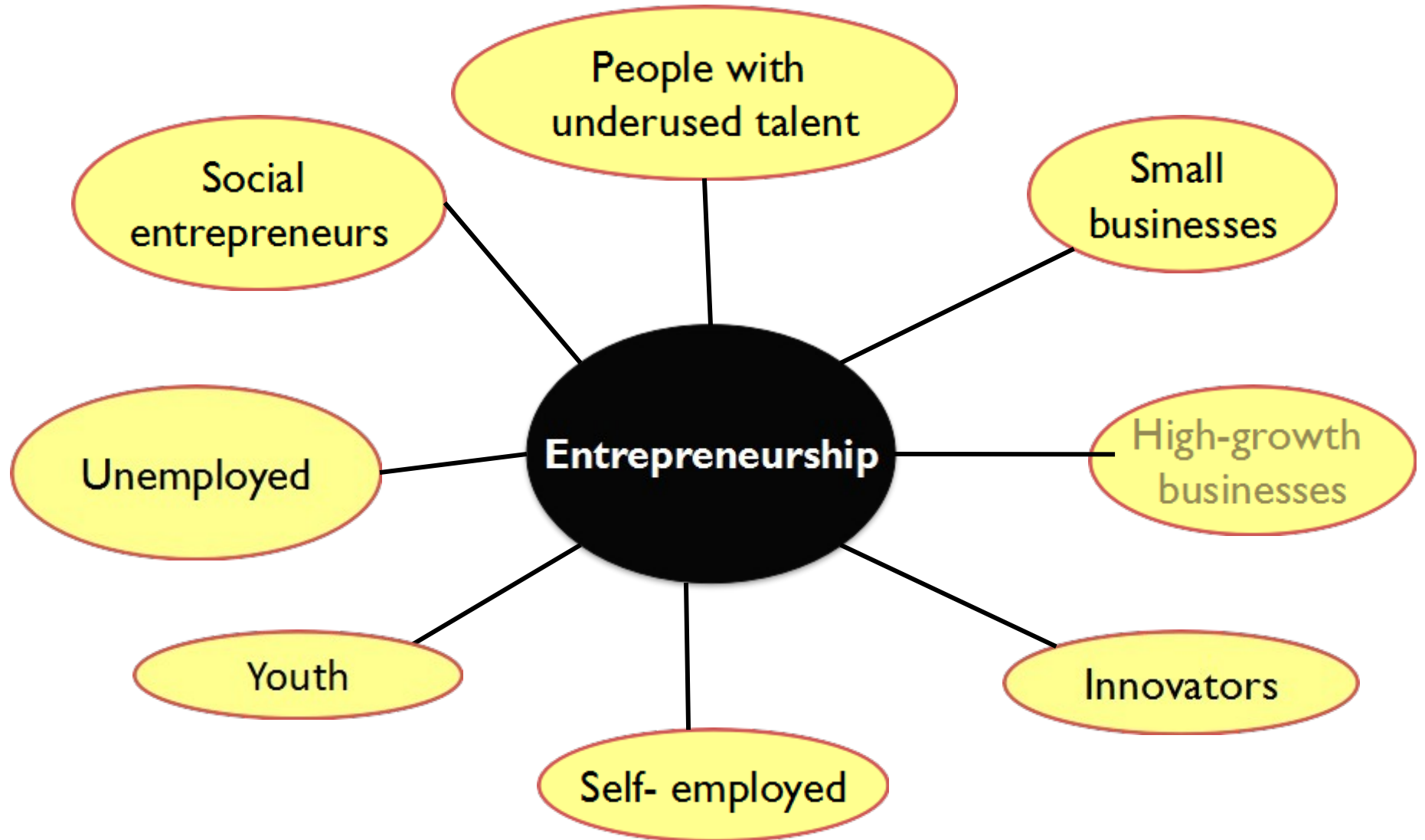
➤ **Entrepreneurship:**
