MEANING AND CLASSIFICATION OF VALUES

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What does value mean?

- Values refers to the attribute of being worthwhile / important/ purposeful in terms of the resources that of finance, information, men and materials.

Classification of Values

- Objective values
- Subjective values

Objective values:

- Objective values otherwise called absolute values, viz. Truth, Beauty and goodness (universal in nature).
- The absolute values are valued the values crises – across the world irrespective of age, gender, race, continent, nation, religion, community, culture etc.

Subjective values:

- The values which are subject to differ from person to person and even within a person from time to time as well as context to context. These values are known as subjective values.
- Examples,
- The values like secularism, spiritualism, nationalism and internationalism.

- **ACADEMIC** – Knowledge ,Thinking, Creativity, Attitude, Skills.
- **AESTHETIC** – Longing for beauty, Sensation, Action, Satisfaction.
- **CAREER** – Aspiration, Determination, Effort, Adjustment.
- **CULTURAL** – Customs, Mores, Norms, Monuments.
- **DEMOCRATIC** – Freedom , leadership, Collectivism, Minority Care.

accounting

➤ ETHICAL

– Sincerity, Punctuality, Loyalty,
Devotedness

➤ FAMILY WELFARE – Oneness, Interaction, Care,
Wealth, Love and affection.

➤ HEALTH

– Environment, Exercise, Diet,
Forward thinking.

➤ HUMANISTIC – Empathy , Charity, Care for living beings, Forgiveness.

➤ INTERNATIONAL – Acceptance of ideas from other Nations, Respect to other Nations, Interdependence, Unity and integrity.

➤ MANUAL LABOUR – Reward of manual work, dignity,
Family and Community work.

➤ MORAL – Discipline, Modesty, Honesty, Faithfulness,
Gratitude, Respect.

➤ NATIONAL – Rational thinking, Heterogeneity ,
Service to Nation, Mobility, Coalition building.

➤ PEACE – Love , sacrifice, Fairness, Justice.

➤ POLITICAL – Courage , Power, Authority, Civic
sense.

➤ PRODUCTION – Ideas , Reprocessing, Innovation,
Discovery.

➤ PUBLIC WELFARE – Prohibition , Protection,
Conservation .

➤ RECREATION – Adventure , Refreshment, Pleasure
Seeking , Profit.

➤ SCIENTIFIC – Objectivity , Alternate thinking,
Verification, Cause - effect practice,
Novelty.

- SECULAR – Equality , Tolerance, respect to all Religions, Liberty in worship.
- SOCIAL – Co operation, community service, Revolt against social evil, sharing at crisis, Equity and access.
- SPIRITUAL – Love of beings, worship, Soul refinement, yoga and meditation.
- SPORTS – Discipline , Motor skill development, Physical Competence, Team spirit.
