National Library Week Celebration - 2024

The Department of Library and Information Science at the university celebrated National Library Week 2024. As part of the event, an extensive training workshop was organized on methods for accessing and utilizing research data. The university's esteemed Vice-Chancellor, Dr. A. Selvam, delivered the keynote address at both the closing ceremony of the library week and the opening of the workshop.

In his address, he emphasized that research must be conducted with complete involvement and a commitment to quality, enabling researchers to independently carry out meaningful studies. He highlighted the importance of using research techniques and technological advancements in research to benefit students. Furthermore, he stressed the need for proper acknowledgment when utilizing others' research findings or data and encouraged researchers to generate their own data through independent efforts.

The workshop detailed various national and international research databases and explained their applications, outcomes, and the methods for students to upload their data to global platforms, fostering worldwide collaborations. The Vice-Chancellor also underscored that artificial intelligence (AI) is a useful tool but should not overshadow human intelligence. He advised students to create research outputs, whether articles or data, in their original narrative style.

Dr. S. Srinivasaragavan, Senior professor and librarian, gave the introductory address, he has highlighted the relevance of research data set towards enhancing the research productivity and narrated in the out line of day long workshop.

Following this, the Chief Librarian and Knowledge Officer of the Indian Institute of Management (IIM) delivered the key note address. He discussed how global research is advancing and the impact of data resources. He mentioned critical research data sources like the World Bank, Reserve Bank of India, and other economic research repositories, along with how students and researchers can effectively use the research databases available at IIM.

Chief Librarian of Thiyagarajar College of Preceptors 'Education' Dr.N. Sundar, presented on open science, open research, and open data resources, explaining how researchers and educators can access and upload their research data. He provided step-by-step guidance for effectively sharing and managing research outputs.

A quiz competition conducted online engaged students, and winners from Jamal Mohamed College and university departments received cash prizes of ₹1000 and certificates. A session on using artificial intelligence in research and academic writing, delivered by experts, provided insights into leveraging AI tools effectively.

The workshop also featured a video demonstration on visual experiments by a U.S.-based organization JOVE Dr. S. Ranganathan, professor & Head, delivered the vote of thanks.

The events attended by more than hundred participants from various colleges and universities across the state and a few from neighbouring states.

During the closing ceremony, Registrar Dr. Kalidasan presented certificates to students and faculty who participated in the workshop. He emphasized that such events enhance the learning quality of university research. The program coordinators, Dr. Surulinathi, Assistant Professor and Syndicate Member, and Dr. N. Amsaveni, Assistant Professor, as coordinators played key roles in organizing the event.
